**Three radio antennas, 600 dish, two cabinets all at roof level**

response by WCC Internet 20.9.11

Comments : Objection.

1 The location is just outside the Conservation Area, and the visual impact of the existing installations are appalling, especially given the architectural quality of Hope House. To add three more, a 600 mm dish and two cabinets - all of which will add to the visual clutter is unacceptable.

2 The increased level of radio transmission that would result is unacceptable. The local community is not persuaded by the applicants' literature that there is unlikely to be any ill effects to those living so close - even on the opposite side of the road: especially taking into account the increased concentration of activity. We are very concerned on health grounds. We see no justification for increasing the activity in this location.

3 The Thorney Island Society considers the health of the residential community in the area should not be further potentially put at risk any further than it is. We find the proposals unacceptable and recommends the Committee (whose members do not live in the vicinity) to refuse Planning consent.
